BAC Resolution Declaring Single Calculated Responsive Bid (SCRB) and Recommending Approval

RESOLUTION No. 60 series of 2018

- WHEREAS, Cebu Normal University posted an Invitation to Bid for the procurement of One Lot One Year Contract to Provide Security Guard Services for the CNU Buildings, Premises and Facilities for the Period from January 1 to December 31, 2019 with Bid No. 18-10-1062 with an Approved Budget for the Contract of Five Million One Hundred Twelve Thousand Four Hundred Fifty-Nine Pesos and Sixty Centavos (Php 5,112,459.60) in the PhilGEPS and in a conspicuous place at the premises of Cebu Normal University;
- WHEREAS, per BAC Resolution No. 53 series of 2018 dated December 7, 2018, GAPROTEC Security Inc., the lowest bidder as read, was declared disqualified for non-compliance to Section 32.2.1(a) of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184;
- WHEREAS, per BAC Resolution No. 55 series of 2018 dated December 20, 2018, Cafe Security and Investigation Agency, Inc. was declared post-qualified;
- WHEREAS, Cafe Security and Investigation Agency, Inc. submitted the post-qualification requirements on time;
- **WHEREAS,** Cafe Security and Investigation Agency, Inc. was compliant to all the requirements; hence, responsive;
- NOW THEREFORE, we, the members of the Bids and Awards Committee, hereby RESOLVE as it is RESOLVED:
 - a) To declare Cafe Security and Investigation Agency, Inc. as the Single Calculated Responsive Bidder in the bidding for the procurement of One Lot One Year Contract to Provide Security Guard Services for the CNU Buildings, Premises and Facilities for the Period from January 1 to December 31, 2019 with Bid No. 18-10-1062; and
 - b) To recommend for approval by the Board of Regents of Cebu Normal University the foregoing findings and to award the contract to Cafe Security and Investigation Agency, Inc. in the amount of Five Million One Hundred Twelve Thousand Four Hundred Fifty-Nine Pesos and Sixty Centavos (Php 5,112,459.60).
